This course will explore 200 years of Mexican History: from the struggle for independence in 1810, through the 1910's upheaval known as "the world's first social revolution," and well into the Twenty First Century. It will trace the ways in which politicians, diplomats, soldiers, educators, "intellectuals," artists, and writers attempted to build a "national identity" for a society fractured by geography, deep economic inequalities, culture, language, class and ethnicity.
