**The Global and Mexican Environmental Agenda:
Saving Nature or Saving the Economy**

Most of the official policies and programs to save the planet, raised at national and international levels, do not seek to save the planet, but to save the economy. We will take as a case of concrete study the international policy of climate change, existing international agreements, particularly Kyoto and Paris, the positions of developed and undeveloped countries (Mexico among them) before these agreements, policy proposals, their scope and, particularly, the factors that explain its meager results. In general terms, we will review the social foundations of the contemporary environmental crisis and the way in which this crisis is reflected in the Mexican reality.
